SECOND AMENDED COMPLAINT**


Before the Court is the Plaintiffs’ Unopposed Motion to File Second Amended Complaint, [Doc. 140](#). [Fed. R. Civ. P. 15\(a\)\(2\)](#) provides that where a party is not entitled to amend as a matter of course, “a party may amend its pleading only with the opposing party’s written consent or the court’s leave.” The parties have consented that Plaintiffs should be given leave to file the proposed Second Amended Complaint.
