Dear Judge Conley:

On behalf of the Edwards Plaintiffs, we have reviewed the July 10, 2020 Emergency Motion of the WEC Defendants [DNC Dkt. #425] seeking relief from certain discovery obligations imposed on those defendants by plaintiffs in these actions.

I did not participate in the call with the Court late Friday Afternoon, but I have spent time this weekend working with counsel for the WEC Defendants seeking to resolve the dispute on behalf of my clients. In the Edwards case, the WEC Defendants were concerned solely with Request for Production Nos. 4 and 5, which requests were appended to Daniel Lenz's letter of Friday Afternoon and are incorporated herein by reference.

I am pleased to report that the WEC Defendants and the Edwards Plaintiffs reached a compromise earlier today over the dispute, which obviates the need for judicial intervention at this time. While I understand the Swenson Plaintiffs are continuing to work with Mr. Lenz on their particular dispute, the Edwards and Swenson Plaintiffs coordinated in the interest of efficiency and judicial economy to the extent that the two plaintiff groups' requests overlapped, as is the case with a portion of Request Nos. 1 and 2 interposed by the Swenson Plaintiffs.


