On May 31, 2017, Intervenor-Defendants served a subpoena duces tecum 2 seeking records from the FBI. 3 Some of the documents responsive to Intervenor-Defendants' request 2. constitute "records" as defined by the Privacy Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552a, in that they include 4 identifying information about an individual, including names, identifying numbers, 5 addresses, and other information. 6 3. Pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552a(b), this information may not be disclosed 7 without the written consent of the individuals to whom the record pertains unless it falls 8 into one of the statutory exceptions listed at §§552a(b)(1) through (12). One of these 9 statutory exceptions allows the government to disclose information covered by the Privacy 10 Act pursuant to the order of a court of competent jurisdiction. See, 5 U.S.C. §552a(b)(11). 11 4. Therefore, the parties request that the Court enter an Order pursuant to 5 12 U.S.C. § 552a(b) allowing the FBI to disclose relevant documents in this case which are 13 subject to the Privacy Act. A proposed Order is included herewith. 14 5.
