**PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE *INSTANTER* REPLY MEMORANDUM
IN SUPPORT OF THEIR EMERGENCY MOTION FOR TEMPORARY
RESTRAINING ORDER IN EXCESS OF TWENTY PAGES**

Pursuant to Section I of this Court's Standing Orders, Plaintiffs the League of Women Voters of Ohio, Ohio A. Philip Randolph Institute, Lashunda Lee, Munia Mostafa, Audrianna Victorian Rodriguez, and Hannah Tuvell ("Plaintiffs") respectfully move this Court for leave to file the attached reply memorandum in support of their Emergency Motion for Temporary

Restraining Order (ECF No. 4) in excess of twenty pages. The reply memorandum is 27 pages, and is attached as Exhibit A to this motion.
