**[PROPOSED] ORDER  
GRANTING PLAINTIFFS’  
MOTION FOR INJUNCTION  
PENDING APPEAL**

Plaintiffs have moved for an injunction pending appeal. For good cause shown, the Court hereby **GRANTS** the injunction and orders the following:

1. It is **HEREBY ORDERED** that Plaintiffs’ motion for injunction pending appeal is **GRANTED**.
2. Defendant, her officers, agents, servants, employees, and all persons in active concert or participation with them are **ENJOINED** from taking any action to enforce, or implement the Ballot Order Statute.
3. Defendant, her officers, agents, servants, employees, and all persons in active concert or participation with them are **ORDERED** to implement a nondiscriminatory name rotation system that gives similarly-situated major-party candidates an equal opportunity to be placed first on the ballot.
4. No person who has notice of this injunction shall fail to comply with it, nor shall any person subvert the injunction by sham, indirection or other artifice.
5. The bond requirement is hereby **WAIVED**.
6. This injunction will go into effect immediately and shall remain in effect pending further order from this Court.
