15	enforce, or implement the Ballot Order Statute.	
16	3. Defendant, her officers, agents, servants, employees, and all persons in active	
17	concert or participation with ther	m are ORDERED to implement a
18	nondiscriminatory name rotation syster	n that gives similarly-situated major-party
19	candidates an equal opportunity to be placed first on the ballot.	
20	4. No person who has notice of this injunction shall fail to comply with it, nor shall	
21	any person subvert the injunction by sham, indirection or other artifice.	
22	5. The bond requirement is hereby WAIVED .	
23	6. This injunction will go into effect immediately and shall remain in effect pending	
24	further order from this Court.
