Dear Ms. Dodszuweit:

I write on behalf of Appellant Kathy Boockvar, in her capacity as Secretary of the Commonwealth, to supply the statistics requested in the Court's letter of November 10, 2020.

The current approximation of the number of absentee and mail-in ballots received by mail between 8:00 p.m. on November 3, 2020, and 5:00 p.m. on November 6, 2020, is **9383**. The county boards have segregated those ballots.

With respect to the number of ballots that lack a legible postmark, we have received estimates from **62 of 67** counties—every county except Lehigh, Northumberland, Tioga, Warren, and Wayne. Our current approximation is that **655** of the ballots received by those 62 counties lack a legible postmark.
